**CUSTOMS BROKER LICENSURE EXAMINATION
RESULTS RELEASED IN TWO (2) WORKING DAYS**

The Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) announces that **1,030** out of **2,022** passed the Customs Broker Licensure Examination given by the **Board for Customs Brokers** in **Manila, Cebu** and **Davao** this **November 2016**.

The members of the Board for Customs Brokers who gave the licensure examination are **Nenette T. Dagondon**, Officer-In-Charge and **Rolando L. De Jesus**, Member.

The results were released in two (2) working days after the last day of examination.

Registration for the issuance of Professional Identification Card (ID) and Certificate of Registration will be done on-line. Please go to www.prc.gov.ph and follow instructions for initial registration. Those who will register are required to bring the following: Notice of admission, duly accomplished Oath Form or Panunumpa ng Propesyonal, 2 pieces passport size picture (colored with white background and complete name tag), 2 sets of documentary stamps. **Successful examinees should personally register and sign in the Roster of Registered Professionals.**
