**CHEMICAL ENGINEER LICENSURE EXAMINATION

The Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) announces that **199** out of **383** passed the Chemical Engineer Licensure Examination given by the **Board of Chemical Engineering** in **Manila** this **April 2012**.

The members of the Board of Chemical Engineering are **Engr. Ofelia V. Bulaong**, Chairman; **Engr. Francisco A. Arellano** and **Engr. Jeffrey G. Mijares**, Members.

Registration for the issuance of Professional Identification Card (ID) and Certificate of Registration will be on May 14, 2012. Those who will register are required to bring the following: duly accomplished Oath Form or Panunumpa ng Propesyonal, current Community Tax Certificate (cedula), 3 pieces passport size picture (colored with white background and complete nametag), 1 piece 1" x 1" picture (colored with white background and complete nametag), 2 sets of metered documentary stamps and 1 short brown envelope with name and profession and to pay the Initial Registration Fee of ₱600 and Annual Registration Fee of ₱450 for 2012-2015. **Successful examinees should personally register and sign in the Roster of Registered Professionals.**

The date and venue for the oath-taking ceremony of the new successful examinees in the said examination **WILL BE ANNOUNCED LATER.**
