**CHEMICAL ENGINEER LICENSURE EXAMINATION
RESULTS RELEASED IN ONE (1) DAY**

The Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) announces that **380** out of **641** passed the Chemical Engineer Licensure Examination given by the **Board of Chemical Engineering** in **Manila** and **Cebu** this **November 2010**.

The members of the Board of Chemical Engineering are **Engr. Ofelia V. Bulaong**, Chairman; **Engr. Francisco A. Arellano** and **Engr. Jeffrey G. Mijares**, Members.

Registration for the issuance of Professional Identification Card (ID) and Certificate of Registration will start on Monday, December 6, 2010 but not later than December 10, 2010. Those who will register are required to bring the following: duly accomplished Oath Form or Panunumpa ng Propesyonal, current Community Tax Certificate (cedula), 3 pieces passport size picture (colored with white background and complete nametag), 1 piece 1" x 1" picture (colored with white background and complete nametag), 2 sets of metered documentary stamps, and 1 short brown envelope with name and profession; and to pay the Initial Registration Fee of ₱600 and Annual Registration Fee of ₱450 for 2010-2013. **Successful examinees should personally register and sign in the Roster of Registered Professionals.**

The oathtaking ceremony of the successful examinees in the said examination as well as the previous ones who have not taken their Oath of Professional will be held before the Board on Friday, December 17, 2010 at 1:00 o'clock in the afternoon at the Manila Hotel, One Rizal Park, Roxas Boulevard, Manila. Registration for the oathtaking ceremony and for membership with the **Philippine Institute of Chemical Engineers (PICHE)** will take place after registration as a professional with the Board and the Commission.
