**CHEMICAL ENGINEER LICENSURE EXAMINATION
RESULTS RELEASED IN ONE (1) DAY**

The Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) announces that **301** out of **638** passed the Chemical Engineer Licensure Examination given by the **Board of Chemical Engineering** in **Manila** and **Cebu** this **November 2011**.

The members of the Board of Chemical Engineering are **Engr. Ofelia V. Bulaong**, Chairman; **Engr. Francisco A. Arellano** and **Engr. Jeffrey G. Mijares**, Members.

Registration for the issuance of Professional Identification Card (ID) and Certificate of Registration will start on December 5, 2011 but not later than December 9, 2011. Those who will register are required to bring the following: duly accomplished Oath Form or Panunumpa ng Propesyonal, current Community Tax Certificate (cedula), 3 pieces passport size picture (colored with white background and complete nametag), 1 piece 1" x 1" picture (colored with white background and complete nametag), 2 sets of metered documentary stamps and 1 short brown envelope with name and profession and to pay the Initial Registration Fee of ₱600 and Annual Registration Fee of ₱450 for 2011-2014. **Successful examinees should personally register and sign in the Roster of Registered Professionals.**

The date and venue for the oathtaking ceremony of the new successful examinees in the said examination **WILL BE ANNOUNCED LATER.**
