 - h. One (1) piece Long Transparent (non-colored) Plastic Envelope (for keeping your valuables and other allowed items)
 - i. NON-PROGRAMMABLE CALCULATORS (REFER TO THE LIST ON THE **EXAMINEES GUIDE)**

 - b. PROGRAMMABLE CALCULATORS
