Successful examinees should personally register and sign in the Roster of Registered Professionals.

The oathtaking ceremony of the successful examinees in the said examination as well as the previous ones who have not taken their Oath of Professional will be held before the Board on Saturday, May 1, 2010 at 1:00 o'clock in the afternoon at the Bahay Kalinaw, U.P. Diliman, Quezon City.

Registration for membership with the **Philippine Association of Landscape Architects, Inc. (PALA)** will start on Monday, April 5, 2010.
