The Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) announces that **82** out of **96** passed the Metallurgical Engineer Licensure Examination given by the **Board of Metallurgical Engineering** in **Manila** and **Davao** this **October 2017**.

On October 25, 2017, registration for the issuance of Professional Identification Card (ID) and Certificate of Registration will be done on-line. Please go to [www.prc.gov.ph](http://www.prc.gov.ph) and follow instructions for initial registration. Those who will register are required to bring the following: duly accomplished Oath Form or Panunumpa ng Propesyonal, notice of admission (for identification only), 2 pieces passport sized pictures (colored with white background and complete name tag), 2 sets of documentary stamps and 1 piece short brown envelope. **Successful examinees should personally register and sign in the Roster of Registered Professionals.**

The date and venue for the oathing ceremony of the new successful examinees in the said examination **WILL BE ANNOUNCED LATER.**
