**SANITARY ENGINEER LICENSURE EXAMINATION
RESULTS RELEASED IN ONE (1) WORKING DAY**

The Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) announces that **49** out of **99** passed the **Sanitary Engineer Licensure Examination** given by the **Board of Sanitary Engineering** in **Manila** this **September 2010**.

The members of the Board of Sanitary Engineering are **Engr. Corazon De los Reyes-Romero**, Chairman; **Engr. Alfredo B. Espino** and **Engr. Florimond M. Lara**, Members.

The results were released in one (1) working day from the last day of examination.

Registration for the issuance of Professional Identification Card (ID) and Certificate of Registration will start on Monday, September 27, 2010 but not later than Tuesday, October 12, 2010. Those who will register are required to bring the following: duly accomplished Oath Form or Panunumpa ng Propesyonal, current Community Tax Certificate (cedula), 2 pieces passport size picture (colored with white background and complete name tag), 1 piece 1" x 1" picture (colored with white background and complete name tag), 2 sets of metered documentary stamps, and 1 short brown envelope with name and profession; and to pay the Initial Registration Fee of ₱600 and Annual Registration Fee of ₱450 for 2010-2013. **Successful examinees should personally register and sign in the Roster of Registered Professionals.**

The oathtaking ceremony of the successful examinees in the said examination as well as the previous ones who have not taken their Oath of Professional will be held before the Board on Friday, October 22, 2010 at 1:00 o'clock in the afternoon at the Sulo Hotel, Matalino Road, Diliman, Quezon City.

Registration for membership with the **Philippine Society of Sanitary Engineer, Inc. (PSSE)** will take place after registration as a professional with the Board and the Commission.
